Dress code is enforced, and you may purchase or rent a dress for the semester. Fees will be announced at the 3rd rehearsal. Rental fee is 45.00 per semester. Men must rent or buy black tuxedos for each concert.

- (1) Choral Ensemble is a group-based activity. For that reason, weekly attendance is paramount.
- (2) While individual practice outside of class is expected and required, the ensemble experience cannot be acquired individually.
- (3) Rehearsals begin promptly at 7:45 p.m. Tardiness is not acceptable. (see Assessment Methods) If you must be absent, due to illness or an unavoidable conflict, you must be excused by the instructor (Lynn Staininger), not your section leader. Failure to notify the instructor will result in a total loss of points for the rehearsal. In the case of long term absence, you must contact the instructor to see if completion of the class is possible.
- (4) The rehearsal and performance elements of this class are designed to encourage all participants to learn and improve upon the skills necessary in a successful choral ensemble such as: good physical posture both seated and standing; proper breath support; proper vowel formation as applicable to style; correct pronunciation of foreign languages; good intonation and vocal color, engaged facial and body language and understanding of composers studied.

At Frederick Community College, in all credit courses, students are expected to invest a minimum of two hours completing out-of-class course work for every hour of instructional time.

This class will require individual, out of class, practice of your choral parts. Additional sectionals and lessons may be included in this out-of-class work.
